

# 2010 DCON DRESS CODE

## **Casual Attire:** Registration, Meet & Greet, Free Time

**Everyone:** Casual attire refers to shorts or jeans, collared shirts, sweatshirts, or appropriate t-shirts and casual footwear for males, and shorts, skirts, skorts, or jeans, collared shirt, sweatshirt, or appropriate t-shirt and casual footwear for females

**Do Not Wear:** pajamas, short shorts, short skirts, or shirts that do not cover the midriff, and any overly revealing clothing.

## **Business Casual Attire:** Workshops

**Males:** Slacks, Collared Shirt, Dress Shoes

**Females:** Appropriate Dress, Skirt, Slacks, Blouse, Collared Shirt, and Dress Shoes

**Do Not Wear:** Flip flops/sandals, short skirts or short dresses, T-shirts, shorts, jeans or sneakers

## **Professional Attire:** General Sessions, House of Delegates, Caucuses

**Males:** Complete Suit with Dress Shoes {Dress Pants, Shirt, Tie and Coat}

**Females:** Business dress or Business Suit with Dress Shoes {Dress Pants or Skirt, Blouse and Jacket}

**Do Not Wear:** Flip flops/sandals, short skirts or short dresses, T-shirts, shorts, jeans or sneakers

## **Formal Attire:** Governor's Farewell Banquet and Ball

**Males:** Suit with Dress Shirt or Tuxedo, Bow Tie or Neck Tie, Suit Jacket (Must be Worn at All Times), Dress Shoes.

**Females:** Formal Dress or Sunday Dress with Dress Shoes.

**Do Not Wear:** Flip flops/sandals, short skirts or short dresses, T-shirts, shorts, jeans or sneakers
