

How FLOF Works

1. Members join Key Club
2. Members pay dues
3. \$1.00 per member deposited into FLOF Account
4. Member come up with brilliant idea for a service project
5. Key Club needs money project
6. Key Club applies for FLOF grant
7. District Treasurer receives application
8. FLOF Committee decides on grant request
9. If approved, Key Club receives check for service project
10. Key Club plans project
11. Key Club has project and takes pictures
12. Key Club send Follow -Up Report and pictures to District Treasurer
13. FLOF is successful in helping out a Key Club in need

Florida Opportunity Fund

What is the Florida Opportunity Fund?

The Florida Opportunity Fund, better known as FLOF, is the Florida District of Key Club International grant program. When clubs apply for the FLOF grant, we ask that they be willing to raise at least half of the funds that will be needed for the project. If you request \$300 from the FLOF Fund, make sure your club is willing to work and raise an additional \$300 to go towards the project.

Where does FLOF money come from?

DUES! Out of the 11 bucks each member sends to International, \$4.50 goes to Florida. One dollar of this money goes into the FLOF Fund for grants.

How much money can I get from FLOF?

FLOF grants range from \$100 to \$1000 dollars. If a club applies for a FLOF grant for \$300 and later in the year wants \$700 for another project, the club may apply for a second grant. A club may not request more than \$1000 in a single Key Club year and may not receive all of the money it applies for.

How to Apply



Who can get a grant from FLOF?

Any Key Club in the Florida District can get a grant as long as they have paid dues, attend DCM's, and attended their Key Club Kick Off Conference and Spring Rally. FLOF will not accept applications from individual Key Club members (except Lieutenant Governors). The club must approve as a project of that club any service project for which the club is applying for a FLOF grant.



What else is required?

The FLOF Committee must verify that the FLOF grant was used as described in the application. Therefore, a FLOF Follow-Up Report must be filed within three weeks of the project's completion and must include at least ten pictures of the event and copies of all receipts. Failure to file a Follow-up Report will result in the club having to return all money to the District.
