The 72nd Annual Florida Key Club District Convention Registration Extension

Dear Florida Key Club,

Although we are close to our maximum capacity at this point, we want to give every Key Club the opportunity to attend this year's DCON and make this the biggest convention ever. The convention committee has decided to extend the registration deadline to **March 10, 2010**. Please take the opportunity to use this deadline to gather more Key Clubbers to the biggest Florida District Key Club gathering of the year. In addition, every Key Club should have at least one member in attendance so this extension and the low registration cost should make it possible for every club to be represented.

Also, in order to bring in the most money for scholarships, the convention program advertisement deadline has been extended as well. We can accept camera ready advertisement up to March 20th. Remember that seniors from clubs who sell at least \$100 in advertisements will be eligible for these scholarships. Note that March 1, 2010 is when Section I and Section III of Contest and Awards are due.

Below is important information regarding the **March 10th** deadline:

1. The March 10th extension applies only to online registrations and you can still pay by check.
2. If your club decides to pay by check, you have a grace period of 7 days after you submit your registration for us to receive your payment.

3. Paper registrations mailed after **Feb. 20th** will cost the additional \$50 fee per registrant.
4. For registrations received after February 20th, we may not be able to arrange to have all rooms and chaperones near each other.
5. Room availability is limited, so later registrations may need to be turned down. In this case, all money is refundable.

Q & A

So, can we still add people after March 10th and still get the check in by March 17th?

No, your club must be registered by March 10th and we must receive your payment within seven days thereafter.

Due to the extension, more Key Clubbers from my club want to go, but we already sent our payment. Can we add more Key Clubbers?

Yes, you can still add Key Clubbers up until March 10th. Remember to send in the payment to be received within seven days.

How much is the registration if we send in a paper registration after Feb. 20th instead of submitting online?

Any paper registration postmarked after February 20th will cost an additional \$50. Avoid this fee by submitting your registration online on or before March 10th at: <http://www.floridakiwanis.com/keyclubdcon/>

As a chaperone, will my students and I be located near each other for convenience?

Every attempt will be made to cluster the chaperons and their students together. Understand that the later registrations are received, the more difficult this is to accomplish.

Can we send our Contest and Awards Certification Form together with our payment?

No, please note that the Contest and Awards Certification Form has a different address than the registration payment. And the awards submissions deadline is still March 1, 2010. Go here for more information: <http://www.floridakeyclub.com/dcon/contestandawards>.

Are you planning to extend the Medical Authorization and Code of Conduct deadline?

No, since we want to make registration a breeze just like last year, this is the latest possible date you can mail in the forms. If you have not mailed the

forms by March 20th, bring the papers with you to convention. Always make copies of these forms for yourself.
